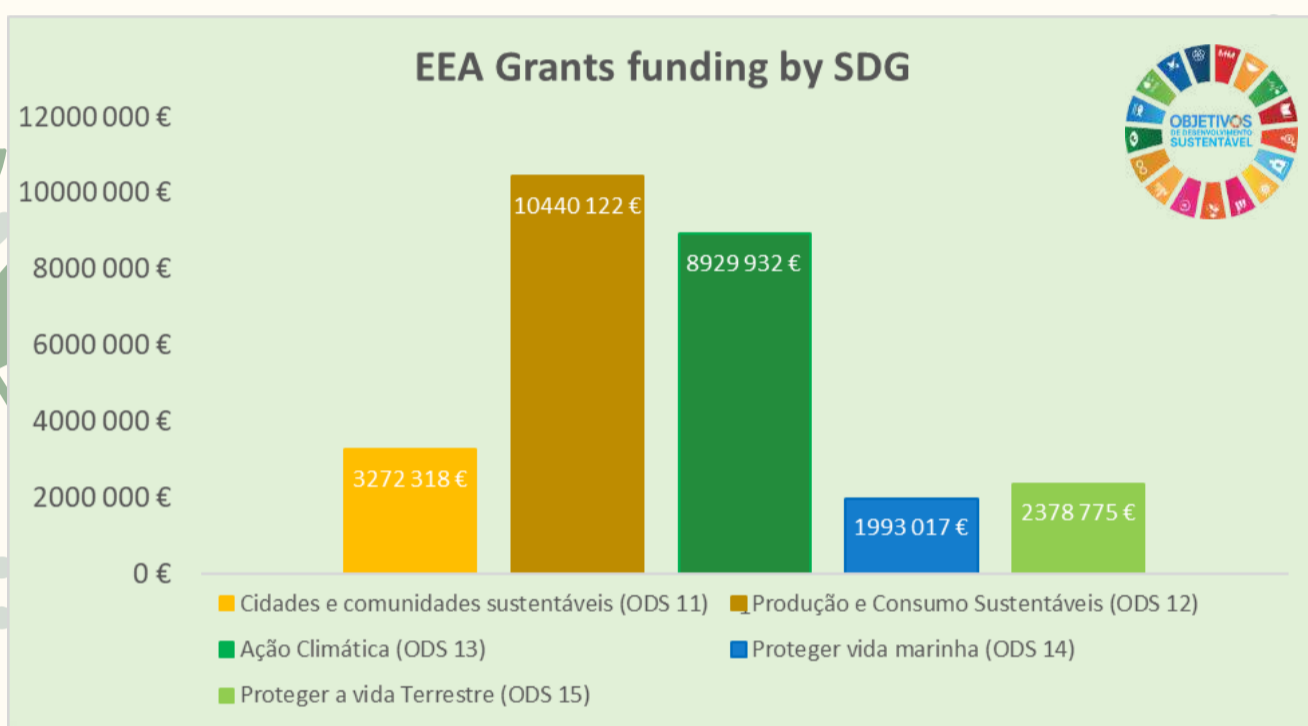


# SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS (SDG)

They establish a common vision for humanity in the face of the current growth model that will improve people's living conditions.

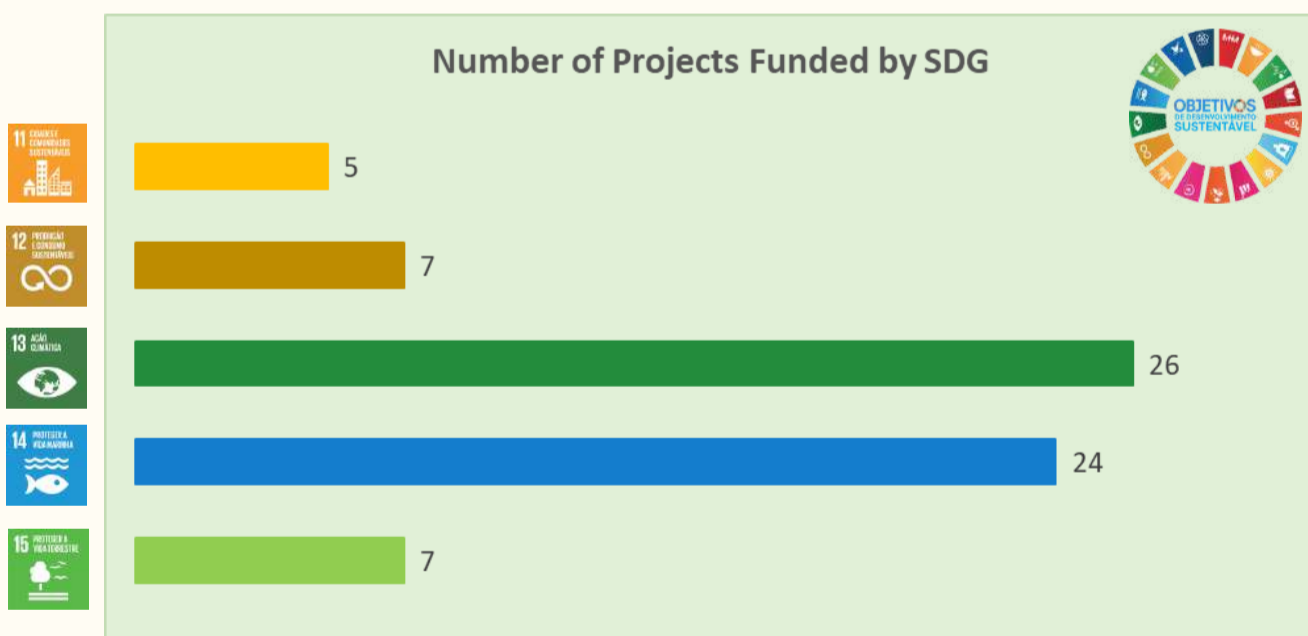
The EEA Grants Environment Programme finances projects that promote the circular economy, value the territory and decarbonize society.

## Contribution of Environment Programme projects to the SDG



### LIVING LABORATORIES FOR DECARBONIZATION

Guarantee all citizens access to smart lighting, sustainable mobility and decarbonization in their daily lives, reducing and mitigating the impact of climate change in cities.

### CIRCULARITY EXPERIENCES FOR PACKAGING AND CONSTRUCTION WASTE

The implementation of a deposit and refund system for non-reusable packaging (plastic, aluminum and glass) and the circular economy in construction waste, allowing these materials to be removed from landfills and reducing their material footprint.



### ADAPTATION TO CLIMATE CHANGE AT LOCAL LEVEL

Increased resilience and adaptation capacity of urban, riverside and rural areas to the effects of climate change and its impacts at local level.



### REDUCE THE IMPACT ON PLASTIC IN THE OCEAN

Avoid significant adverse impacts on the oceans, seas and marine resources, the proliferation of marine litter, and fishing nets and equipment on the seabed that cause ghost fishing.



### COMBAT DESERTIFICATION, SOIL CONSERVATION AND BIODIVERSITY.



Recover and promote the sustainable use of terrestrial ecosystems, sustainably manage forests, combat desertification, halt and reverse soil degradation and limit the loss of biodiversity.
